Welcome, if you are interested in joining our radio control flying club that uses a site on Allaire State Park off Hospital Road, Wall Township NJ. You will need to provide our club with the following documentation:

- 1.) You need an AMA membership, the website <https://www.modelaircraft.org/> look for the tab JOIN RENEW on the top page banner. And follow the information on the website. Once you pay the AMA, they will provide a membership card or a conformation email from the AMA with all the appropriate information.
- 2.) You will also need to obtain the FAA license by visiting the website <https://faadronezone-access.faa.gov/> Look for the tab RECREATIONAL FLYERS on the top banner. You will need a FAA Small UAS Certificate of Registration. Make sure you look for recreational aircraft. A small fee is required, and the FAA registration is valid for a couple of years.  
Obtain and retain your log in information as you will need it for renewing in the future.
- 3.) Also, at the same website you will need to take the TRUST test (you cannot fail this test) however it contains valuable information concerning safely and responsibly flying Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS). (R/C aircraft). Make sure you print and obtain the completion certificate.
- 4.) Additional club paperwork could be provided at a meeting, electronically sent or USPS mailed to you. Once you have compiled all the appropriate documents (a copy of), items 1,2 and 3 above. You will need to complete our club's New Member Verification Information Form and the appropriate year JCRCC Safety Code.

Our site is a FRIA Sites (FAA Recognized Identification Areas) and therefore does not require any remote IDs to fly. We attempt to meet every 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month (weather permitting) at the flying field at noon. If the front gate is open, please feel free to stop by and say **hello!**
